Transition Assistance Program

The Transition Assistance Program (TAP) is offered under a partnership between the Department of Defense, the Department of Veterans Affairs, the Department of Homeland Security (e.g. the Coast Guard), and the U.S. Department of Labor.

Retiring veterans have 24 months prior to their discharge to access the TAP, and those separating from the military (i.e. ending a tour of duty or coming to the end of a contracted enlistment) have 12 months prior to access TAP.
